We may amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. The New Zealand Resuscitation Council Inc. is a New Zealand-owned business for trading and registration purposes.

Attendance

The sponsors and exhibitors understand that all company representatives must register officially.

Booking Conditions

Acceptance of sponsorship/exhibition applications will be subject to the organising committee approval. The organising committee reserves the right to decline applications based on any association, direct or indirect, that does not uphold the objectives of the conference.

Booth Allocation

Exhibition booths will be allocated strictly in order of receipt of application and payment and the organising committee's decision will be final.

Cancellation Policy

- In the case of the cancellation of sponsorship, unless all sponsorship is resold, we reserve the right to retain monies received.
- In the case of the cancellation of a booth, please note that unless we can sell the space we reserve the right to retain all monies received.

Price

Prices are in New Zealand dollars unless otherwise specified and are GST exclusive.

Payment

We will advise you of your invoice details and payment can be made by direct payment to our bank account or via credit card.

Payment must be received within the time frame specified on your invoice. We reserve the right to cancel any sponsor/exhibitor application for which payment has not been received by the due date.

Overdue invoices and queries

We may take whatever action necessary to recover debt on an overdue invoice. The debtor will be liable for any costs incurred in pursuing the debt.

If you have a dispute in relation to any amount in an invoice please contact us immediately to discuss. We are not obliged to investigate a disputed amount if you do not notify us about it within 30 days.

Responsibilities

The sponsor/exhibitor shall

- Properly manage and conduct their use of the exhibition area and the performance of their obligations under this Agreement:
- Ensure all their representatives at the event behave in a responsible manner to ensure the safety of all persons and property and the preservation in and around the Venue;
- Do all things necessary to ensure compliance with the terms of this agreement
- Be responsible and liable for any loss/damage to the venue, or the building or fittings directly or indirectly by the use of the venue by the sponsor/exhibitor where such loss or damage is caused by the sponsor/exhibitor, or their representatives;
- Be responsible for security of any property brought to the venue and for any insurance to cover that property;

Signage, alterations and fixings

Consequential Damage

The NZ Resuscitation Council will not be liable for any indirect or consequential damages arising out of a breach of this exhibition contract.

Variations

The NZ Resuscitation Council may in the event of any circumstance which renders it necessary vary the booth space allocation and the sponsor/exhibitor will accept such reallocation without any claim for a reduction in charges or otherwise.

Unavoidable Occurrences

In the event that the event is cancelled or delayed through no fault of the NZ Resuscitation Council, or the Venue Manager including but not limited to fire, flood, labour disputes, riots, insurrections, Government action, work stoppages, slowdowns or disputes, or other similar events then the sponsor/exhibitor shall not be entitled to any refund or to claim for any loss or damage.

Assignments and subletting
